

## \*{Early Guidance}\* How can I get my money back from Kraken?

Getting your money back from Kraken ⚡ [1-(803)-(250)-5847]✓ simply means ⚡ [1-(803)-(250)-5847]✓ withdrawing your funds—either as cryptocurrency or traditional fiat currency—back to a wallet or bank account you control.
